2. Proposed year activity or action for provinces and branches + methodologies:

2015 Leadership and Training Conference

This event took place at the Don Bosco Youth Centre in Gauteng from the 06th to the 10th December 2015.

Help a child campaign

Around the first two weeks of April 2016

This event has no restrictions of any kind or any particular programme to be followed, but the ultimate goal is to reach out to children e.g. it could be by means of charity visits, primary schools visits or to the ones in streets.

Acts going green

Make sure that all communities understand and are prepared to cooperate to tackle this problem.
